



THE DEVIL'S IN THE DETAILS: CONSCIENTIOUS OBJECTION RULE VACATED DUE TO DHHS OVERSTEPPING SCOPE OF AUTHORITY

The Department of Health and Human Services (“DHHS”) issued a Rule in May 2019, allowing both health care workers and health care institutions to refuse providing abortion, sterilization, assisted suicide, or other such services if the individual or institution cited a religious or conscientious objection to those services (the “Rule”).
